## **CA May Day Trek 2017**

### **Short Route 6 miles**

1. Turn left out of the church and right on to Blackbrook Road
2. Turn right at the footpath sign and walk along the flat path (the conduit) [Marshal 15]
3. At the end of this path cross the road and the path continues slightly to the right
4. At the end of this path turn left onto Soughey Lane and walk uphill (note no footpath) [1.5 miles] [Marshal 14]
5. At the end of Soughey Lane, turn right onto the footpath
6. When reaching the first reservoir keep to the right; there is a stone wall to your right
7. Over a small bridge, bear right and walk on the road between the 2 houses. [Marshal 16]
8. Just after the houses turn left and walk uphill on the road.
9. At the top of the road turn right onto the footpath. [2 miles]
10. At the end of the footpath cross a small bridge, through a small stile and turn left onto Redmires Road. [Marshal 17]
11. Follow Redmires Road to the end of the road. [3 miles] [Marshal 13]
12. At the end of the road, carry straight on through the squeezer and follow the Yorkshire Water concessionary path along the south side of the reservoirs. (*You do not cross any of the dams; there are a couple of paths – all end up at the same point. Half way along the third reservoir drop down to water's edge.*)
13. Go through gate by third dam, bear left along the path closest to the wall on your right, and then right after a short distance, continue to the road. [Marshal 14]
14. Turn left down Soughey Lane and then right after about 200 metres onto the second public footpath. [4.5 miles]
15. Follow this path (*the conduit*) to the next road.
16. Bear right and carry on along the conduit. Turn left at end to return to St. Luke's church. [6 miles]. *We hope you enjoyed the walk.*
